Fall continued busy with workshops, guild programs, and fiber exhibits.

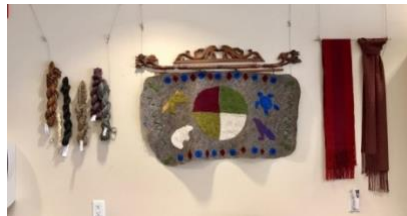
**October** – Was a busy month starting with a Tapestry workshop with Kathe Todd Hooker
