Class descriptions

Adventures with Weaving Lace - From two shaft pick -up techniques to beautiful eight shaft loom controlled patterns, this round-robin workshop is sure to provide something new and exciting for everyone, novice and experienced weavers alike. Drafts will be provided - bring your loom ready to weave. Materials fee -- \$30.

Colorplay on Cellulose - Dye a variety of fibers including a cellulose scarf warp (rayon, cotton or bamboo) as well as yarn and fabric. Use techniques of binding and crowding to dye a warp or quilting fabric, or paint a skein with Procion MX dyes. Mordanting will be covered. This class is useful for anyone who weaves, spins and sews, whether for garments or quilting.

ECOPrint - Using natural dye elements such as leaves, blossoms, sticks, mushrooms, lichen, cochineal bugs, logwood, each student will print and take home a lovely silk scarf. We will go WILDCrafting to find some of the materials; students may also want to bring a bag of STUFF from their yard or garden...start putting them in the freezer NOW!

Intro to Natural Dyeing - Learn how to dye with weld, onion skins, madder, cochineal, logwood and indigo! We will learn the basics of mordanting, extracting pigment, making a dye bath, overdyeing, as well as color shifting in an after-bath. Materials fee -- \$36. *** **Students need to bring: Sturdy Rubber Gloves, Apron and a shallow Rubbermaid type tote box for transporting batching goods.** ***

Meals: Meals will be buffet-style, and will have a variety of foods that can accommodate omnivores, vegetarians, gluten free diets, etc.

Accommodations:

Green Springs Inn is 17.5 miles East of Ashland, Oregon - a 25 minute drive on Highway 66, or about one hour from Klamath Falls.
