Feb. We placed our challenge yarns into identical bags and then drew a bag. Project will be due at our Dec. Luncheon. It is a thrift type store that mostly specializes in hand crafts along with useful tools. We have enough interest that we will follow up on it.

We had a mini workshop on peg looms. We had enough for most folks to work on one with either fabric strips or wool roving.

Mar. We mostly worked on baskets or other projects we have. Unfortunately, no one brought either a finished or unfinished peg loom rug started last month. We will be starting up our UFO mtgs held on a Sunday once a month. This year we decided we will keep track of how many projects get finished and say if I finish one, everyone else in the group will toss a quarter into the kitty. We'll decide later on how we will spend the money at the end of the year.

Apr. We firmed up at date in June for our annual dye day. We will be ice dyeing once again as that has been so popular. We will possibly go on our road trip to "The Makers Apron" in May.
